HERE'S HOW TO SHOW YOUR CRITICAL UNDERSTANDING

Artist's Life

- Where and when was the artist born?
- Was he/she part of a group of artists or an Art movement?
- Which other artists influenced him/her?
- Who did he/she influence?
- What was the subject matter of their work usually (e.g figures, still life, landscape?)
- Were they a founder of a new type of art?

Content

- Which artist created this piece of work?
 What is it called? When was it created?
- What can you see in the art work?
- What materials have been used?
- How have the materials been used? (technique)

Formal Elements (the bits that make up the picture)

- Describe the colour scheme. What colours can you see? are they all warm or cold colours? Are there any colours that contrast each other (make each other stand out)?
- What shapes can you see? How large/small are they? How many are there?
- Are there any patterns or lines? Where?
- Is there any text? Where? What does it sav?
- How would you describe the texture of the picture? Does it look rough/smooth etc?
- Where are the light and dark areas? Are there shadows?
- Does the image look 3D or quite flat? Where?

Visual Language (the message behind the picture)

- What mood do you get from the picture?
 How does it make you feel? Why?
- What time of day/time of year do you think it is?
- If there's writing, was do you think it means?
- What do you think the image is about?
 What does it remind you of? What does it make you think about?

<u>Composition (how the picture has been put</u> together)

- How are the shapes and lines arranged?
- Are there any gaps?
- What do you notice first in the picture?
- How do the formal elements guide your eye around the image?
- Can you draw a diagram to show the compositional design?
- Have they used the rule of thirds, framing, fill the frame, leading lines, balancing elements, depth, symmetry, pattern, negative space?

Personal Opinion & Analysis (get higher marks for analysis!)

- Do you like the image? Why? Which bits in particular?
- Is the work typical of a movement or group of artists (e.g Cubism)
- Is the work typical of the artist's overall style? Explain why it is similar/dissimilar to their other work.
- What does the art work make you think/feel? Which elements force you to think/feel this?
- Explain the differences between his/her earlier work to his/her later work.
- What did the artist say about his/her work?
- What did other people think to his/her work?
- How has the work inspired your own work?
 What specifically do you like about the work/style that you will develop into your own work?
