When analysing any piece of Art, you should think about the following questions.

Remember to use VCOP to help with sentences and use key words! You have learnt (there are also some on the wall in the Art room!)

	Identify what you can see in the picture, what is the picture of?

	Describe how shapes, objects or patterns relate to each other; do they overlap?

	Explain what you think the work is about.

	Predict why you think the artist created it.		
	Does the work relate to their other work? Is it all a similar style?		
	Accomplished analysis		
	Justify why you think the work is about that?		
	Does the work relate to other artist's styles?

	Identify the colours used and the mood they could relate to.		
How it	Basic/Reasonable analysis		
makes	Explain why those particular colours illustrate that mood/feeling.

feel	Can you predict what mood the artist was try to show? How do you think the		
	artist was feeling at the time?		
	Confident analysis		
	Analyse how effective the artist was at creating a particular feeling/mood.		
	Accomplished analysis		
	Evaluate how the work makes you feel, explain why and give examples.		
PROCESS	Basic analysis		
	Identify which materials you think were used to create the work?		
How it was	Basic/Reasonable analysis		
created	Explain why you think those materials were used.		
	Does the work look rushed or have they taken their time to make it? <u>Reasonable</u> <u>analysis</u> Summarise the materials used and how suitable they are for this piece. Why do		
	you think the artist chose these materials in particular?		
	Explain why you think it looks rushed/like it's taken a long time.		
	Confident analysis		
	Predict what the work would look like if it had been created using different		
	materials (e.g. paint, clay, pencil etc)		
	How do you think the materials have been used? Have they used special tools or		
	actions? (E.g. messy brushstrokes, dots, layered paint etc).		
	Accomplished analysis		
	Evaluate how effective the choice of materials is for creating the effect.

	Evaluate how effective the arrangement (composition) of the shapes, colours,			
	textures, lines etc has been. How do they all work to guide your eye around the work and keep your attention?			
	How could you be inspired by the work? Predict what you could try in your own work.
